In order to grant a better equipment allocation and sustain the growing costs of terminal storage and handling Transinsular has set a D&D policy.

Bellow our D&D matrix concerning all detention and demurrage at destination port.

Detention and Demurrage charges per destination

Free Time – Number of days, counting from the day after a container is discharged from the vessel, in which there is no cost applicable.

Demurrage – Additional charge for exceeding the Free Time at the discharging port's terminal.

Detention – Additional charge applied to customers that, after picking up the equipment from terminal, keep it in their possession exceeding Free Time
